

NEWS: THE OUTLOOK FOR TRAVEL IN 2021

Last year, the travel world saw a drastic change as a result of COVID-19, from the decreased number of people in airports and on flights to the new incorporation of contact tracing. As the amount of travelling – both for work and leisure – has begun to increase, questions regarding the safety and possibility of travel in 2021 seem countless.

Many travel plans were adjusted or cancelled last year because of the global pandemic. With both concern for one's own health as well as the health of others, along with the inability to visit certain places, travel became increasingly difficult.

Looking forward into 2021 and the optimistic projections of recovery from (or at least the decline of) the pandemic, many are hoping that they will be able to travel more this year. Whether that means rescheduling cancelled vacations or planning new getaways, future travel is highly anticipated because of the major decline last year.

In order to travel, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention suggests getting a COVID-19 test beforehand and ensuring the results are negative. Depending on the traveler's destination, proof of a negative test might be required in order to board transportation or stay at hotels, or even to enter a particular country, depending on its rules. It is also recommended to get tested after traveling, and to quarantine until receiving a negative test result.

International travel will likely have the largest degree of risk and requirements, as it typically requires air transportation, and different countries have diverse COVID protocols and laws. Considering countries' desire to decrease COVID cases, the need to isolate after arriving someplace new will likely remain in place for months. Vaccine passports – documents proving one's previous vaccination – will likely be required. Some airline CEOs, such as those at Delta and Qantas Airways, are considering requiring travelers to be vaccinated before boarding a flight.

According to the CDC, "all air passengers coming to the United States, including U.S. citizens, are required to have a negative COVID-19 test result or documentation of recovery from COVID-19 before they board a flight to the United States." If a U.S. citizen travels outside the country and catches COVID during their trip, they are required to remain isolated where they are and may not return to the United States until receiving negative test results.

It is also recommended to review the risks of traveling as well as the safest ways of traveling. Visiting places with a high number of COVID cases and interacting with many people is significantly riskier than going to a place with fewer cases and remaining more isolated.


One positive development in the travel world, particularly with airlines, is that there might be more flexibility with bookings in the future. Previously, many airlines enforced strict restrictions and cancellation fees. However, as society has adapted to the global pandemic conditions and begun recovery with the release of vaccines, many of these fees have disappeared, thus making it reasonable to expect that booking will remain flexible for future travelers.

Although international travel will be more difficult, travel within the United States is more likely to increase in appeal because of its somewhat greater safety and ease. With travel via car available to many and the added security of mainly visiting outdoor sites (beaches, lakes, mountains) many might find road trips safer and easier to do.

That being said, if COVID numbers happen to increase significantly, any form of travel could become out of reach. The importance of safety (personal and community health) remains significant for any kind of travel. If unsafe travelers contribute to the spread of COVID, then not only will travel become less possible, but the health of others who are not traveling — including people who are at high-risk for COVID – may be jeopardized.
